### SELECTED JOBIM CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Composed Film Score for 1958 “Black Orpheus” with Luiz Bonfa, that won an Academy Award
- “Desafinado” & “Samba de Una Nota” were the most popular songs on the groundbreaking 1962 “Jazz Samba” album that launched the world-wide Bossa Nova phenomenon
- Composed 22 film scores
- Dubbed by many as the “George Gershwin of Brazil”
- “Aguas de Marco” named as the all-time best Brazilian song in poll of 200 Brazilian musicians, journalists, And other artists by Brazil’s leading daily newspaper, Folha de Sao Paulo in 2001
- 32 of his songs were cited in the above poll, with 7 being listed in the top 10
- 10 charted albums on Billboard Jazz or Pop Charts
- Credited on over 300 albums as performer, composer or arranger by <http://www.allmusic.com/>
- Over 400 songs published, including many recorded by hundreds of well known Jazz & Pop Artists
- After his death in 1994, Rio de Janeiro’s largest Airport was re-named after him
